I want to provide you with an update on our testing program. We have the Test-and-Stay portion up and running and will soon have our surveillance testing in place. Having a weekly surveillance program will allow us to closely monitor our schools, head off any potential outbreaks, and maintain in-person instruction. Additionally, we can use test results to make any necessary adjustments to our safety measures.

Testing is not mandatory for staff and families. However, the greater the level of participation the more effective the program will be in keeping our community safe.
