- 1. All players are students first and athletes second. Keep up with your schoolwork. Poor grades in school and not completing homework will result in disciplinary actions by the coaches. Mandatory study Hall
- 2. Be Coachable.
- 3. Respect other players, your teammates are working with you not against you. Respect ALL players
- 4. Each member of the team has the responsibility of being a good citizen at all times. This includes periods of time that are not during the normal school day. Actions of each member of the team reflect (either positively or negatively) on the entire team and program. Do the Right Thing!
- 5. No Drugs, Alcohol or Tobacco products
- 6. It is the players responsibility to work extremely hard during practice. A player's effort during practice and in game situations affects the amount of playing time they will receive. You can control your attitude and effort level
- 7. All players are expected to attend all practices!
- 8. Equipment issued to you at the beginning of the season is your responsibility. We expect all players to respect their equipment at the equipment of others.

When a student chooses to join the Martha's Vineyard football team they make a commitment to each of their teammates to prepare themselves academically, to be good citizens, to work as hard as they can during practices and respect all of their teammates, coaches and managers.
