- Items that were scored 'Vague' will be re-written in more specific terms or referencing
  USDA requirements. Links to the USDA website will be provided where appropriate.
- 'Not Mentioned' items will be added to the Wellness Policy
  - Food and beverages served at class parties & infrequent school sponsored fundraisers
  - Time per week of physical education instruction, and before/after school activities available
  - Physical education exemption and substitution requirements for students
  - Active transport for students within walkable/bikeable distance
  - Using physical activity or withholding physical activity as a reward or punishment
  - Encouraging staff to model healthy eating and physical activity behaviors
  - Family and community engagement opportunities
- Other Suggested Edits
  - Mentions of vending will be deleted, as vending machines have been removed
  - Mention of school garden will be deleted until the garden can be replanted and maintained
