- **Goal I, Part I**
 - **School Spirit** - Has improved since last year, still needs to foster Freshmen & Sophomores - need to bridge classes. Sheila suggested a buddy system. Perhaps a Flex in the Fall for Freshmen with Upper Classman students. Similar to reading buddies. More fans would come if we had evening games. Boys & Girls should have night games, at least one game per sport. Use Flex as ways to engage students.
 - **Sports** - Have a Flex for all sports for team captains to talk about expectations and learn more about the sport to help encourage engagement. culture by promoting collaboration and engagement.
 - **Working Students** - figure out ways to engage students who work and have strong work commitments, create college-like work study opportunities, paid internships
 - **Club Fair** - Have a second club fair. Have a club fair flex for club leaders, have information ready for students for club fair Second Club Fair. Flex for descriptions of clubs in PAC
